Reliable Solution to Discovery of Miscellaneous Hazardous Waste Drums

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Unlabeled, miscellaneous drums were identified during a client move and put a halt to operations.
2. LTE responded immediately, conducted sampling and on-site treatment (as appropriate), overpacked drums, identified recycling and/or disposal companies to handle the different waste streams, and got the drums removed from the site in a timely manner to keep operations moving.



CHALLENGE:

Oilfield service companies are faced with ever-growing regulatory compliance requirements. Whether it is developing compliance plans or conducting reporting, it can become difficult to manage all the moving parts. A recent project with a prominent oil field services company involved identification and materials management of miscellaneous containers of hazardous materials discovered during the moving process.

APPROACH:

Because we've worked with the client for more than 20 years, we were well equipped to handle this situation. LTE worked closely with both the client and regulatory agencies and followed compliance protocols to find creative solutions for materials management including recycling, on-site treatment, and off-site disposal. In addition, LTE provided client staff (250+) with waste management training to prevent future occurrences.

RESULT:

LTE was able to recycle two-thirds of the materials by identifying industrial users willing to accept and reuse the materials in their existing processes such as fuel blending operations, incineration fuels, and waste oil recycling. Our approach provided reliable solutions to problems associated with facility operations that ultimately reduced operating costs, provided more sustainable waste management processes, and kept business moving.
